

IMPACT OF FMF

Familial Mediterranean Fever (FMF) affects people of Mediterranean ancestry. Most patients respond to treatment, however available treatment options are not suitable for everyone.¹

PHYSICAL IMPACT

Median age of first FMF attack:²

2 years

Key severe symptoms experienced by FMF patients:²

- Arthritis
- Fatigue
- Fever
- GI upset
- Inflammation

DELAYED DIAGNOSIS

78%

of patients saw up to 2 different physicians prior to being diagnosed²

48%

of children were either not diagnosed or misdiagnosed before seeing a specialist²
